


Executive Summary

- The CRDM Study Guide ("CRDM Basics") simply and effectively outlines the basics of CRDM in a single, easy-to-understand document
 - Serves as a concise and non-intimidating reference that complements other training and makes employees more effective

- The guide has become a globally recognized tool at Medtronic.
 - Originally conceived as an IDP item, but later expanded, enhanced, and promoted through individual initiative
 - Initially spread across Medtronic informally, but has since been permanently embedded within CRDM and shared across other business units
- The tool has positively impacted hundreds of Medtronic employees and helps the company achieve a better return on investment in training!



What is the CRDM Study Guide?



- Consolidates information from multiple sources into one, simple, concise document
- Outlines concepts in easy to understand language, with links to more detailed info

Provides information instead of overwhelming a reader with content




