- 1989: Graduated from the University of California, San Francisco
 Earned Juris Doctor (JD) law degree
- 1990: Worked for 26 years as a Legal Prosecutor in California
 1990-1997: Worked as a Deputy District Attorney in California and
 - prosecuted cases involving gang violence, drug trafficking, and sexual abuse o 1998-2002: Worked as Assistant District Attorney of San Francisco and
 - oversaw the prosecution of repeat offenders

 2000-2002: Worked as Assistant City Attorney of San Francisco, where she

 Earned a Bachelor of Science (BS) degree in Economics
- 1969: Worked for 27 years in New York City Real Estate
 - o 1973: Took control & renamed father's company as The Trump Organization
 - o 1974: Completed his first major real estate deal: Grand Hyatt New York
 - o 1975-1982: Expanded his real estate empire in Manhattan
 - o 1983: Opened the Trump Tower
 - o 1984-1989: Expanded into casinos and other Trump branded products
 - o 1986: Successfully restored Wollman Ice Rink in NY City's Central Park
 - o 1987: Published Trump: The Art of the Deal
 - o 1990-1994: Faced financial troubles / debt restructuring / business setbacks
 - o 1995: Published Trump: The Art of the Comeback
